The Research and Scholarship Council (RSC) is excited to host the Fall 2025 Research and Scholarship Showcase (RSS) from **Monday, December 1, 2025, to Friday, December 5, 2025**. The RSS is a public forum for the presentation of various scholarly endeavors undertaken by FranU faculty, staff, and students. All students, faculty, and staff are invited to submit an abstract to present a poster at the RSS. The abstracts will be reviewed by the RSC, and all accepted will have their poster displayed in the Atrium from 8:30 am Monday, December 1, 2025, until noon Friday, December 5, 2025.

Because the RSS will feature scholarship from a variety of disciplines, we encourage submissions of various types of scholarly work, not just research. Examples could include, but are not limited to, evidence-based practice, quality improvement projects, demonstrations of teaching innovations, literature reviews, works of creative writing, and personal reflections on community service. Submissions may be individual, group work, or interprofessional collaboration.

Student abstracts must have a faculty advisor who will approve the abstract and final poster before submission. Faculty advisors must be included as an author on the poster.

FranU faculty, staff, and students who wish to have their projects considered for acceptance into the RSS should submit abstracts of no more than 300 words using the link below. All abstracts are due by midnight, Monday, November 10, 2025. Presenters will be notified on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, if their abstract is accepted.
