STATISTICAL PROFILE
Calendar Year 2017

- **Programs Offered** – Programs available for students admitted for enrollment included: 1 doctoral degree, 5 master’s degrees, 7 bachelor’s degrees, and 3 associate-level degree programs. Additionally, 1 non-degree/certificate program was offered.
- **Student Enrollment** – 1418 Spring (84% female, 16% male); Summer 563 (82% female, 18% male); Fall 1374 (84% female, 16% male).
- **Credit Hours** – The University generated 32,200 student credit hours in 2017 (14,103 in spring; 3,436 in summer; 14,661 in fall).
- **Program Enrollment** – During the fall semester, 86% of students were enrolled in undergraduate academic degree programs, 13% were in graduate degree programs, and 1% was enrolled in technical programs. Thirty eight percent of students were enrolled as majors in the School of Nursing; 48% in the School of Arts and Sciences and 13% in the School of Health Professions (this includes enrollment in non-degree programs).
- **Age Characteristics** – The average age of students at FranU is 28. Seventy-one percent of the student body is under 30 years of age, and 13% is over 40 years of age.
- **Ethnicity Characteristics** – Thirty percent of those attending FranU self-identify as U.S. Students of Color: 16.7% Black or African American; 3.3% Asian; 8.7% Hispanic; .4% Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander; and .7% American Indian/ Alaska Native.
- **Religious Affiliation** – Thirty-five percent of our students self-identify as Catholic. The remaining 65% self-identify as something other than Catholic (30% Christian, Non-Catholic; 30% Unknown; 5% Other).
- **Geographic Distribution** – Sixty-four percent of the student body lists their parish of residence as East Baton Rouge (37%) or a parish within a 75-mile radius, primarily Ascension, Livingston, Tangipahoa or Lafayette. Ten percent of our students were from states other than Louisiana.
- **Degrees Conferred** – FranU awarded 357 academic degrees in 2017. Following the spring semester, 222 degrees were awarded (25% associate; 60% baccalaureate; 15% masters). Completion of the summer term led to 11 additional degree conferrals (100% baccalaureate). Completion of the fall semester led to 124 additional degree conferrals (2% associate, 80% baccalaureate, 1% masters, 17% doctoral).
- **Faculty** – The University employed 78 full-time faculty members (both 10-month and 12-month contract), laboratory instructors/coordinators, and draws as needed from a pool of well qualified professionals who serve as adjunct faculty.
- **Staff** – University constituencies are served by 86 professional and support staff members in enrollment services, student affairs, academic affairs, business affairs, development, institutional effectiveness, library, technology, and administrative support positions including extra duty Baton Rouge police officers and non-work study student workers. This also includes Deans.
- **Budget** – The University’s operating budget for Fiscal Year 2017 was \$23,773,632.
- **Physical Plant** – The University occupied twelve buildings near Our Lady of the Lake Regional Medical Center in South Baton Rouge.
